Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration [220] and defendant's motion for judgment as matter of law [212] are both denied as to the reasons stated more fully on the record. Deliberations begin. Jury returns a verdict. The jury has found that the defendant committed 45,600 reckless or intentional violations of the Biometric Information Privacy Act.
